

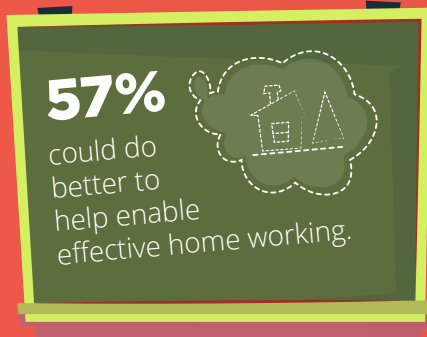
HOW IS LOCKDOWN BRITAIN COPING WITH HOME WORKING?

5. Kitchen (**8%**)



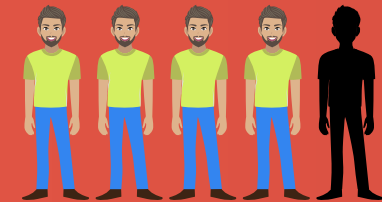
